- Supporting documentation of the unpaid experience in which you will be participating  
*Note: In some instances students will not have received notification that they have been accepted to an opportunity for which they have applied. If this is the case, please provide supporting materials that indicate the position which you hope to participate. Students selected **MUST** provide written documentation of a formal offer confirming their participation in an unpaid position for at least 250 hours from the employer before funds will be disbursed. The deadline for submission of documentation is April 29, 2011.*
