Dean, Faculty of Social Science, Western University, 2015-present

The Faculty of Social Science has 8 departments (Anthropology, Economics, DAN Management and Organizational Studies, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology), approximately 7,000 undergraduates (~35,000 full course equivalents), 700 graduate students, 250 full-time faculty, and 80 full-time staff. It has an annual budget of ~\$60M. Achievements during my term as Dean include:

- **Fundraising**
 - Tripled fundraising targets set by the University's Advancement team
 - 350% increase in annual fundraising (over five previous years)
 - \$15M total increase in Faculty's endowment
 - 4 endowed research chairs established (the Faculty's first endowed chairs)
- **Efficiency and reinvestment**
 - Approximately \$7M of annual base budget recovered for strategic reinvestment
 - Positively incentivized 28 full-time faculty retirements, freeing up ~\$4.5M in base budget
 - Departments worked together to accomplish a 20% increase in the efficiency of undergraduate offerings, freeing up ~\$2.5M in base budget (by offering ~200 fewer elective half course sections taught by part-time instructors)
- **Faculty Renewal**
 - Plans for 54 new tenure/tenure-track faculty searches over four year (34 already completed)
 - By the end of my term, more than 25% of tenure/tenure-track faculty complement will have started their positions while I was Dean
- **Improved Educational Experience**
 - 77% increase in the proportion of undergraduate courses taught by full-time faculty members (44% in 2014-15; 78% in 2018-19)
- **Established a new interdisciplinary research institute**
 - *NEST-Network for Economic and Social Trends*
 - Includes the Faculty's five research centres under one umbrella with the goals of encouraging research synergy across disciplines, and increasing efficiency
- **QS world ranking jumped 57 positions in just two years**
 - Western social science increased from #148 in 2015 to #91 in 2017
- **Highest Dean's office approval rating from tenured faculty and staff**
 - Based on opinions regarding Dean's office performance across Western's 11 Faculties in a University-wide workplace satisfaction survey
