Content Guidelines

- Compare your professional experience, skills and knowledge before and after the internship experience. How will this support your next steps in career and learning?
- How has your experience supported your academics? Or, how did your academic skills support your success on the job?
- How has your internship influenced your plans or career goals for the upcoming year (or post-grad)?

File Format and Submission:

- ➤ Use Zoom to record your presentation with your video turned on (screen share used as applicable). For those of you who enjoy video or animation creation, use of any video creation tool is welcomed (e.g. iMovie, Powtoon, Doodly)
- Visual aids are up to you whatever you find helpful in telling your story effectively, without distracting from your message (i.e. photos, animations, screen shares, sample work/projects, Canva, Prezi or PowerPoint deck).
- Submit your file via a shared web link (i.e. Google Drive, SharePoint) for download in .mp4, .mov or .wmv format.
