
Our program encourages students to ask critical questions about business practices and explore the social and economic implications of organizational decisions, fostering a deep understanding of the business world.

Students can work during summer time for 4 months or take a year off to work for 8.12 or 16 months. which will extend their studies by an additional year to gain valuable work experience.

### **Commercial Aviation** Management

Unique in Canada, this program combines pilot training (IATPL Integrated Airline Transport Pilot License) with comprehensive education in management.
